

SAC GOALS 2007/2008

- Academics:** Research and review Academic Enhancements for Math and submit the results to the principal by September. Measure the success of new programs with dialog from the teachers, parents and students throughout the year. Communicate the results of the programs implemented last year and new programs that may be used this year at the first “Town Hall Meeting” in October. Discuss the results of any new programs with the principal at year-end.
- Facilitate implementation of the pilot Science program adopted by the Dioceses by the start of the school year. Compare the pilot program with the existing program to identify strengths and weaknesses and report this information to the principal.
- Building/Grounds:** The Building and Grounds committee will identify and develop a capital improvement plan to renovate and upgrade the school cafeteria. A plan will also be created to install an intercom/emergency system to connect all the buildings on the property including the church and rectory. These plans should be completed by the end of October. At that time the school and church needs will be prioritized and grants and or donations will be solicited through identified sources. Grants will be applied for in January and February with the projects to be completed over the summer.
- Policy:** Update the School Handbook to include a completed Communication Policy and Athletic Policy. Develop a method to verify parental acceptance of the policy. This will be completed during the first quarter of the 2007-08 school year.
- SCRIP:** Develop policy and procedures for the SCRIP program to create more controls and accountability by December 2007.
- Technology:** Research and complete a technology plan to not only finish what we have started but to update for future needs by December 2007.

To Do's:

1. Reach out to area preschool directors by making personal visits to 2 schools per month with the principal. This will aid in opening the lines of communication and provide information about what St. Monica has to offer.
2. Continue to support the needs of the various ethnic groups at St. Monica through discussions with the students, faculty and administration.
3. Work with the PTO and Dads' Club on developing a written policy for the forward funds by December.
