Group Oral Presentation Component
Focus on Community Social Justice**

Groups should consider:

What has been accomplished? Summarize the work your group has done and the impact you have had.

What tangible progress has your group made?

What successes has your group seen?

What challenges did your group face?

In retrospect, with 20-20 hindsight, would you as a group do anything differently?

Each student should individually consider:

Will you continue your involvement with this particular social issue? Other social issues? Why or why not?

How do you think that this project will influence you as you continue on into high school? College? Adulthood?

What did you personally gain from your involvement in this project?

Presentations should:

Be 5 to 7 minutes in length.

Allow each group member to contribute.

Be thoroughly rehearsed, showing advanced preparation and planning.

Summarize the group project and individual work.

Conclude the service-based campaign, reporting on the overall outcome of the project, as well as the current outlook on community-wide efforts to impact the chosen social issue.
